Two

Better is the end of a thing than the beginning thereof: and the patient in spirit is better than the proud in spirit. Be not hasty in thy spirit to be angry: for anger resteth in the bosom of fools. Ecclesiastes 7:8-9 KJV.

Romans 8:12-17 GNB.

As a result, there is no longer any distinction between Gentiles and Jews, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarians, savages, slaves, and free, but Christ is all, Christ is in all. You are the people of God; he loved you and chose you for his own. So then, you must clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. Be tolerant with one another and forgive one another whenever any of you has a complaint against someone else. You must forgive one another just as the Lord has forgiven you. WATCH YOUR DESIRES

I want you to remember, my brothers and sisters, what happened to our ancestors who followed Moses. They were all under the protection of the cloud, and all passed safely through the Red Sea.

In the cloud and in the sea they were all baptized as followers of Moses. All ate the same spiritual bread and drank the same spiritual drink.

They drank from the spiritual rock that went with them; and that rock was Christ himself.

But even then God was not pleased with most of them, and so their dead bodies were scattered over the desert.

Now, all this is an example for us, to warn us not to desire evil things, as they did, nor to worship idols, as some of them did. As the scripture says, “The people sat down to a feast which turned into an orgy of drinking and sex.”

We must not be guilty of sexual immorality, as some of them were — and in one day 23,000 of them fell dead. We must not put the Lord to the test, as some of them did — and they were killed by snakes. We must not complain, as some of them did — and they were destroyed by the Angel of Death.

All these things happened to them as examples for others, and they were written down as a warning for us. For we live at a time when the end is about to come. Those who think they are standing firm had better be careful that they do not fall. Every test that you have experienced is the kind that normally comes to people. But God keeps his promise, and he will not allow you to be tested beyond your power to remain firm; at the time you are put to the test, he will give you the strength to endure it, and so provide you with a way out.

So then, my dear friends keep away from the worship of idols.

I speak to you as sensible people; judge for yourselves what I say.

1 Corinthians 10:1-15 GNB.

Chapter
Three

RESPECT TO DIVINE AUTHORITY

Remind them to be subject to rulers and authorities, to obey, to be ready for every good work, to speak evil of no one, to be peaceable, gentle, showing all humility to all men. For we ourselves were also once foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving various lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful and hating one another. But when the kindness and the love of God our Savior toward man appeared, not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior, that having been justified by His grace we should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life. This is a faithful saying, and these things I want you to affirm constantly, that those who have believed in God should be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable to men. Titus 3:1

May the lord bless his Word in our heart even as we read to understand. Amen!

A WORD OF EXHORTATION

In the Lord's name, then, I warn you: do not continue to live like the heathen, whose thoughts are worthless and whose minds are in the dark.

They have no part in the life that God gives, for they are completely ignorant and stubborn.

They have lost all feeling of shame; they give themselves over to vice and do all sorts of indecent things without restraint.

That was not what you learnt about Christ!

You certainly heard about him, and as his followers you were taught the truth that is in Jesus.

So get rid of your old self, which made you live as you used to — the old self that was being destroyed by its deceitful desires.

Your hearts and minds must be made completely new, and you must put on the new self, which is created in God's likeness and reveals itself in the true life that is upright and holy.

Ephesians 4:17-24 GNB.

MANAGE YOUR ANGER

Remember this, my dear brothers and sisters! Everyone must be quick to listen, but slow to speak and slow to become angry. Human anger does not achieve God's righteous purpose. So get rid of every filthy habit and all wicked conduct.

Submit to God and accept the word that he plants in your hearts, which is able to save you.

Do not deceive yourselves by just listening to his word; instead,

put it into practice. James 1:19 Prayer:

Lord Jesus, take away every sin in my life that's hindering me from obeying your word.

Lord, take away everything that will not make me achieve your righteous purpose for my life.

I need you oh Lord, help me to submit totally to your word that you have planted into my heart that I may bear fruits of righteousness and holiness, so that I will not fall away from this path of righteousness.

HELP US OH LORD! AMEN!

THE HIGH PRIEST

Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need. Hebrews 4:14-16 NKJV.

Lord Jesus Christ, I come boldly to you today to ask for mercy... I need your grace abundantly over my life and family... You know our pain, you know how we are being tempted, you have been tempted yet you remain without sin...

You know all oh lord!

Father Lord give unto us the grace to hold fast our profession...

Give us grace to stand by your word that we have professed...

Give us grace to stand till the end of our sojourning in this sinful world... Give us grace oh lord!
We need your grace lord Jesus Christ...

Oh Lord teach us to continually trust you no matter what may come our way... Uphold us Lord Jesus Christ till the end...
Amen!

STAYING FOCUSED

Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God;

But exhort one another daily, while it is called "Today," lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end.

Hebrews 3:12-14 NKJV.

May we not lose the focus of our calling.

We have great ASSIGNMENTS to carry out by helping one another (exhorting).

Instead the body is full of self glorification and pulling down of other brethren... This is not the spirit of God, it is the devil.

We have to rise up to our responsibilities as believers. If the focus is on yourself you have missed it...

Daily exhorting one another while it is called Today! Living a day at a time in the fear of God.

Philippians 2:12 KJV.

Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in the newness of life. Romans 6:4 NKJV.

WALK YOUR TALK

People can only see the newness of life through your walk.

NATURE SWAP

BRETHREN PLEASE LET US THINK AND LIVE A DAY AT A
TIME... LIVING TODAY AS IF IT'S THE END OF IT ALL...

BE SOBER! REPENT!!

NOTHING IS WORTH MISSING HEAVEN FOR... I REPEAT

NOTHING!!!

PURGE YOUR HEART

Since you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love of the brethren, love one another fervently with a pure heart, having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever. 1 Peter 1:22-23 NKJV.

Reading through this, it's obvious that the purification of your heart and soul comes from obeying the truth (word of God), through the Holy Spirit and in reality to show sincere love (unfeigned) to everyone. So, if you still harbor hatred towards a brother or a sister you need purification, and it comes by obedience to the word of God.

How can you say you love God that you cannot see and hate your brethren that you can see? Say this Prayer...

Lord Jesus, help my heart and soul to be purged from hatred oh lord... Help me to obey your word... Help me to love everyone as you have loved us oh lord...

Input the power of your love in my heart so that I may love fervently (passionately, sincerely)... Lord, let your word live and abide in my heart forever...

Father Lord help me to be an obedient child of your word in the mighty name of Jesus Christ. Amen!

LET YOUR CONDUCT BE WITH THE FEAR OF GOD

The other day at our bible study, I learnt that as Christians and followers of our master Jesus Christ who has no respect for anyone... he is equal in his DEALINGS with All.

I learnt to treat everyone the same way I will treat a man of God (pastor, prophet, etc.) It's a ministry and that ministry is for edification, equipping and glorifying God. So, now if I humbly treat these people with fear of God, so also I should do to everyone's soul created by God...

Be it young or old, pastor or member, anyone, anywhere at any time... That takes me back to the bible passage that says:
And if ye call on the Father, who without respect of persons judgeth according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning here in fear. 1 Peter 1:17 KJV.

Brethren let us be clothed in humility. 1 Peter 5:5b.

YEA ALL OF YOU BE SUBJECT ONE TO ANOTHER AND BE CLOTHED IN HUMILITY. BEFORE JESUS WAS HIGHLY EXALTED HE WAS HUMBLED EVEN TO THE GRAVE. FOR CHRIST TO BE FULLY REVEALED IN US WE NEED THIS SPECIAL GARMENT OF HUMILITY WHICH IS THE FIRST LETTER OF THE HOLINESS ACRONYM.

MAY GOD HELP US TO BE AMONG THE CHOSEN ON THE LAST DAY. SHALOM!

POWER OVER SIN

Sin must no longer rule in your mortal bodies so that you obey the desires of your natural self.

Nor must you surrender any part of yourselves to sin to be used for wicked purposes.

Instead, give yourselves to God, as those who have been brought from death to life, and surrender your whole being to him to be used for righteous purposes.

Sin must not be your master; for you do not live under law but under God's grace. Romans 6:12-14 GNB.

To the pure all things are pure, but to those who are defiled and unbelieving nothing is pure; but even their mind and conscience are defiled. Titus 1:15 NKJV.

Thinking about this passage; I imagine the state of PURE and the state of being defiled and unbelieving.

Question: *Who shall ascend into the hill of the Lord? Or who shall stand in his holy place?*

Answer: *he that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully. Psalms 24:3- 4 KJV.*

TO THOSE WHO ARE DEFILED AND UNBELIEVING

NOTE: Hebrews 12:15b talks about being careful not to let any root of bitterness spring up lest many be defiled.

...lest any root of bitterness springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled. Hebrews When men are defiled unbelief sets in...

A lot of times, you hear people talk about not wanting to go to church, or this or that, some complain of some certain people in church doing this or that and because of that they withdraw...

Note; *YOU ARE DEFILED* and hence unbelief has set in.

You start to question the existence of God, you neglect the word of God and question everything said to you because you stopped believing...

Remember in Roman 11:20

Well; because of unbelief they were broken off, and thou standest by faith. Be not highminded, but fear.

Romans

Some branches were broken off because of unbelief...

And *TO THE PURE ALL THINGS ARE PURE.* Titus 1:15a NKJV.

Do all things without murmurings and disputings. Philippians 2:14 KJV.

Another passage says:

Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. Philippians 4:8 KJV.

To maintain a pure heart and to avoid defilement, we must heed to this scripture.

TO THE PURE ALL THINGS ARE PURE, EVEN IN THE LAND OF DEFILEMENT THEY REMAIN PURE.

Like Daniel, like Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, who refuse to be defiled and to worship a strange god. Like Joseph in the house of Potiphar, who refused to be defiled and sin against

God.

Like our lord and savior JESUS CHRIST who was tempted at every point and yet remained without sin, who is our perfect example.

Looking unto Jesus Christ, the author and finisher of our faith.

Brethren, let us pray against every form of defilement and unbelief that has shifted our focus from Christ and remove us from the love of Jesus Christ.

Setting our affection on things above and not on things below.

Because: *the things we see here are temporal, but our **HOME IN HEAVEN IS ETERNAL*** 2 Corinthians 4:18.

SHALOM!

WHAT TYPE OF MAN ARE YOU?

Surely men of low degree are vanity, and men of high degree are a lie: to be laid in the balance, they are altogether lighter than vanity. Trust not in oppression, and become not vain in robbery: if riches increase, set not your heart upon them. Psalms 62:9-10 KJV.

Food for thought:

If men of low degree are like vanity and men of high degree a lie,

Both of them together in comparison are lower than VANITY

WHAT IS VANITY?

Dictionary meaning: worthless, futile, uselessness, purposeless, e.t.c.

If Man is lower than this 'vanity'; both men of low and high level, please what is man?

Nothing!!!

Christ made us to be somebody...

We were once alienated, now we are sons and daughters of the Most High, so do not boast about yourself because you are nothing...

All that you are, all that you have or will become is only by his Grace. Boast not in emptiness of self.

But he that glorieth, let him glory in the Lord." For not he that commendeth himself is approved, but whom the Lord commendeth. 2 Corinthians 10:17-18 KJV.

LOVE THE LORD NOT THE WORLD

Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world. And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever. I John 2:15-17 NKJV.

Jesus Christ prayed for his disciples in John 17

He said he has given his disciples the WORD and they're hated because they are not of the world, he passionately prayed that they should be kept from the evil of the world, because they're not of the world even as he is not.

I can feel the effectiveness of that prayer as our Lord was praying... He knows what the world can do to our Christian walk.

There's no way we can please the Lord if we still embrace the world.

Now, these admonitions came to us again in 1 John 2, that we should not love the world neither the things that are in the world.

Scripture itemized how the love of the world can entangle us...

1. The lust of the flesh
2. The lust of the eyes
3. The pride of life

All of these things work together to please the old man.

So we need to pray...

In any way that I am loving the world and the things that are in it, Lord Jesus Christ should separate me from the world by your mercies.

All that I need to walk with you without being trapped down by the old man, dear Lord please provide them unto me abundantly.

The Grace to say NO to the world I received in multiple folds in the name of Jesus Christ.

I want to launch into the love of Christ, to walk with him uprightly, blameless and spotless in the mighty name of Jesus Christ.

I BELONG TO JESUS CHRIST.

GOD'S APPROVAL IS ENOUGH

Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many believed in His name when they saw the signs which He did. But Jesus did not commit Himself to them, because He knew all men and had no need that anyone should testify of man, for He knew what was in man. John 2:23-25 NKJV.

I keep brooding over this passage; a lot of times people come around an individual because they see something that catches their interest, not that they truly love or want to be with these individuals...

Jesus being our perfect example knew the heart of men (Personality of Jesus)... The mistake we often make is committing ourselves to men;

The bible says if a man's ways pleases the Lord he will make even his enemies to be at peace with him...

You don't need men to approve you; settle with God... Obey his commands, walk according to his words... Be obedient children of God.

Commit yourself/life unto the Lord and He will order your steps.

Let him be your master planner, let him be the director of your life, give him YOU! Jesus doesn't need anyone to testify of him...

He doesn't need men's approval;

If you continue to commit yourself to men you will continue to encounter disappointment. **TRUST IN THE LORD AND DO HIS WILL AND HE WILL NEVER FAIL YOU!**

Chapter
Five

DOERS OF THE WORD

We know that we have come to know him if we keep his commands. Whoever says, "I know him," but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not in that person. But if anyone obeys his word, love for God is truly made complete in them. This is how we know we are in him: Whoever claims to live in him must live as Jesus did. 1 John 2:3-6 NIV.

WE CANNOT EXPECT A HOUSE TO BE CLEAN BY OWNING A VACUUM; WE HAVE TO USE THE VACUUM TO CLEAN THE HOUSE.

CLEAN YOUR HOUSE THOROUGHLY BY THE WORD OF GOD NOT JUST BY OWNING THAT WORD BUT BY ALSO APPLYING IT. USE IT TO MAKE YOUR HOUSE CLEAN.

REMEMBER; ONLY THE DOERS OF THE WORD ARE THE CHILDREN OF THE LIVING GOD NOT THE ACTIVIST; NOT THE CHURCH GOERS BUT THE DOERS OF THE WORD.

GOD BLESS YOU ALL.

A WORD OF ADMONITION

Be sure, then, to keep in your hearts the message you heard from the beginning. If you keep that message, then you will always live in union with the Son and the Father. And this is what Christ himself promised to give us — eternal life. I am writing this to you about those who are trying to deceive you. But as for you, Christ has poured out his Spirit on you. As long as his Spirit remains in you, you do not need anyone to teach you. For his Spirit teaches you about everything, and what he teaches is true, not false. Obey the Spirit's teaching, then, and remain in union with Christ. Yes, my children, remain in union with him, so that when he appears we may be full of courage and need not hide in shame from him on the Day he comes. You know that Christ is righteous; you should know, then, that everyone who does what is right is God's child. 1 John 2:24- 29 GNB.

GRACE FOR STEADFASTNESS

Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord. 1 Corinthians 15:58 NKJV.

Oh Lord Jesus I pray that you ignite your fire of service in our hearts in the name of Jesus Christ.

That we all remain steadfast, immovable, always abounding, always available for your work in the love of Christ Jesus in Jesus name.

That every one of us that has surrendered all to follow you will not run in vain in the mighty name of Jesus Christ.

When the roll is called up, we will not be missing in the mighty name of Jesus Christ. Amen!

Lord Jesus, remove every veil that's covering the heart of men.

Make them turn to you completely that they may behold your Glory and power in the name of Jesus Christ. Amen!

But even to this day, when Moses is read, a veil lies on their heart. Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away. Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty.

But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord. 2 Corinthians 3:15- 18 NKJV.

HE FORMED US

For you formed my inward parts; you covered me in my mother's womb. I will praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Marvelous are your works, and that my soul knows very well.
Psalms 139:13

Knowing that he formed the inward and every part of our body is an assurance of healing for us... I pray that the Lord will heal every one that needs divine healing.

Amen!

BREAKING THE HOLD OF THE EVILS OF THE LAST DAYS

Remember that there will be difficult times in the last days. People will be selfish, greedy, boastful, and conceited; they will be insulting, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, and irreligious; they will be unkind, merciless, slanderers, violent, and fierce; they will hate the good; they will be treacherous, reckless, and swollen with pride; they will love pleasure rather than God; they will hold to the outward form of our religion, but reject its real power. Keep away from such people. Some of them go into people's houses and gain control over weak women who are burdened by the guilt of their sins and driven by all kinds of desires, women who are always trying to learn but who can never come to know the truth. As Jannes and Jambres were opposed to Moses, so also these people are opposed to the truth — people whose minds do not function and who are failures in the faith. But they will not get very far, because everyone will see how stupid they are. That is just what happened to Jannes and Jambres. 2 Timothy 3:1-9 GNB.

I pray that we will not be wrapped in the web of these last days' syndromes...

Many are departing from the body of Christ because of things they see happening in the body that aren't edifying. It's the devil that's defiling the body through hearts that aren't yielding to the ways of the Lord.

Let everyone look inward and cry for revival.

DO NOT HOLD ON TO THE THINGS OF THE WORLD

Then Job arose, tore his robe, and shaved his head; and he fell to the ground and worshiped. And he said: Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked shall I return there. The Lord gave, and the Lord has taken away; Blessed be the name of the Lord. In all this Job did not sin nor charge God with wrong. Job 1:20- 22 NKJV.

What is that thing you are still holding onto as important?

What is that thing that occupies your heart which you ought to have submitted to him, who gives and takes away?

The apostles rejoice in all tribulations knowing that *the trying of their faith worketh patience*. James 1:3 KJV.

Even if he will not deliver, never stop loving and worshiping him...
But we know that he will yet deliver...

A WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT

We all face pressure; we all have times we feel overwhelmed and think it's too much. The reason you have big oppositions is because you have a big destiny. The good news is God took all that into account when He designed your infrastructure. He didn't give you a big future with weak walls, with a small foundation, with little beams. Even the tax collectors do that! And if you speak only to your friends, have you done anything out of the ordinary? Even the pagans do that! You must be perfect—just as your Father in heaven is perfect! Matthew 5:43-48 GNB.

This passage always comes back to me each time I feel someone somewhere or somehow hurts me or the other way...

The only thing we tend to do when things happen is to back out, or say “well I'm moving on.” This is the work of Mr. Flesh.

Now, the spirit of God that dwells in a man will make him walk as his father walks...

So many times we fake love because we want people to think we are believers, but after a while your real self comes up and that's when people see the real YOU!

Many believers are ALLOWING Mr.Flesh to rule their life, some call it diplomacy, and some say they're being political.

Whatever you do that contradicts the word of God needs a thorough check and prayer to be free from... It can be one at a time, as they're coming up you are praying Jesus into them...

The word of God said; YOU MUST BE PERFECT... Is being perfect Impossible?

Many people say you can't be perfect...

If the word of God says it is, then you and I can be perfect.

May the Lord God Almighty help and strengthen us to walk as He has walked. May He help us to attain perfection for His glory through Jesus Christ our Lord and savior. Amen!

Chapter
Six

THE INTRICACIES OF LOVE

The Thought on this today is, Can I make a fellow believer love me genuinely?

Love is not based on giving and receiving...

JESUS GAVE US ALL WITHOUT US EVEN COMING TO THE KNOWLEDGE OF HIM LOVING US.

SO, JESUS WASN'T WAITING FOR US TO LOVE HIM BEFORE HE LOVED US; HE CHOSE TO LOVE US WHILE WE WERE YET SINNERS AND UNREPENTANT... (THAT IS LOVE)

I BELIEVE EITHER ANYONE KNOWS OR NOT, WHETHER THEY DESERVE TO BE LOVED OR NOT, WE HAVE NO CHOICE BUT TO LOVE ALL.

As for you, my brothers and sisters, you were called to be free. But do not let this freedom become an excuse for letting your physical desires control you. Instead, let love make you serve one another.

For the whole Law is summed up in one commandment: "Love your neighbor as you love yourself."

But if you act like wild animals, hurting and harming each other, then watch out, or you will completely destroy one another.

And those who belong to Christ Jesus have put to death their human nature with all its passions and desires.

The Spirit has given us life; he must also control our lives. We must not be proud or irritate one another or be jealous of one another.

Galatians 5:13-15, 24-26 GNB.

There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love. We love him, because he first loved us. If a man says, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? And this commandment we have from him, that he who loveth God loves his brother also. 1 John 4:18-21 KJV.

Don't be concerned only about your own interests, but also be concerned about the interests of others.

Have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had... Philippians 2:4-5.

THE DISEASE OF SELF

A common disease I have seen in the body of Christ is this;

A lot of people only care about their own things... Me, me, me is always the language. They set priorities for themselves which alters the word of Christ...

When others try to show concern they tag them as intruders, why? They know deep down that they're not ready to reciprocate that love...

Jesus Christ instructed us to be our brother's keepers...

Is it your immediate younger brother you think he's referring to??
NO! The Brethren! The Believers!

We need one another!

Pray against that spirit of selfishness, self centeredness...

You show love only when you feel it's necessary or at a stipulated time for a set out goal...

Brethren, let's pray for the word of God to be fully revealed in our lives, that we may live to please him that has called us...

Shalom!

A WORD OF ADMONITION

Finally, believers, we ask and admonish you in the Lord Jesus, that you follow the instruction that you received from us about how you ought to walk and please God (just as you are actually doing) and that you excel even more and more [pursuing a life of purpose and living in a way that expresses gratitude to God for your salvation]. For you know what commandments and precepts we gave you by the authority of the Lord Jesus. For this is the will of God, that you be sanctified [separated and set apart from sin]: that you abstain and back away from sexual immorality; that each of you know how to control his own body in holiness and honor [being available for God's purpose and separated from things profane], not [to be used] in lustful passion, like the Gentiles who do not know God and are ignorant of His will; and that [in this matter of sexual misconduct] no man shall transgress and defraud his brother because the Lord is the avenger in all these things, just as we have told you before and solemnly warned you. For God has not called us to impurity, but to holiness [to be dedicated, and set apart by behavior that pleases Him, whether in public or in private]. So whoever rejects and disregards this is not [merely] rejecting man but the God who gives His Holy Spirit to you [to dwell in you and empower you to overcome temptation]. 1 THESSALONIANS 4:1-8 AMP.

The Grace to live a Holy and a Sanctified life the Lord will give unto us all in the mighty name of Jesus Christ...

Amen!

SURRENDER...

I give thanks to Christ Jesus our Lord, who has given me strength for my work.

I thank him for considering me worthy and appointing me to serve him, even though in the past I spoke evil of him and persecuted and insulted him. But God was merciful to me because I did not yet have faith and so did not know what I was doing.

And our Lord poured out his abundant grace on me and gave me the faith and love which are ours in union with Christ Jesus.

This is a true saying, to be completely accepted and believed:

Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners.

*I am the worst of them, but God was merciful to me in order that Christ Jesus might show his *full patience in dealing with me, the worst of sinners, as an example for all those who would later believe in him and receive eternal life.*

To the eternal King, immortal and invisible, the only God — to him be honour and glory for ever and ever! Amen.

1 Timothy 1:12-17 GNB.

DO NOT PASS JUDGMENT

Welcome those who are weak in faith, but do not argue with them about their personal opinions.

Some people's faith allows them to eat anything, but the person who is weak in the faith eats only vegetables.

Those who will eat anything are not to despise those who don't; while those who eat only vegetables are not to pass judgment on those who will eat anything; for God has accepted them.

Who are you to judge someone else's servants? It is their own Master who will decide whether they succeed or fail. And they will succeed, because the Lord is able to make them succeed.

Some people think that a certain day is more important than other days, while others think that all days are the same. We should each firmly make up our own minds.

Those who think highly of a certain day do so in honour of the Lord; those who will eat anything do so in honour of the Lord, because they give thanks to God for the food.

Those who refuse to eat certain things do so in honour of the Lord, and they give thanks to God.

None of us lives for himself only, none of us dies for himself only. If we live, it is for the Lord that we live, and if we die, it is for the Lord that we die.

So whether we live or die, we belong to the Lord.

For Christ died and rose to life in order to be the Lord of the living and of the dead.

You then, who eat only vegetables — why do you pass judgment on others? And you who eat anything — why do you despise other believers?

All of us will stand before God to be judged by him. For the scripture says: “As surely as I am the living God, says the Lord, everyone will kneel before me, and everyone will confess that I am God.”

Every one of us, then, will have to give an account of ourselves to God.

So then, let us stop judging one another. Instead, you should decide never to do anything that would make another stumble or fall into sin.

My union with the Lord Jesus makes me certain that no food is of itself ritually unclean; but if a person believes that some food is unclean, then it becomes unclean for that person.

If you hurt your brother or sister because of something you eat, then you are no longer acting from love.

Do not let the food that you eat ruin the person for whom Christ died! Do not let what you regard as good get a bad name.

For God's Kingdom is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of the righteousness, peace, and joy which the Holy Spirit gives.

And when people serve Christ in this way, they please God and are approved by others.

So then we must always aim at those things that bring peace and that help to strengthen one another

Do not, because of food, destroy what God has done.

All foods may be eaten, but it is wrong to eat anything that will cause someone else to fall into sin.

The right thing to do is to keep from eating meat, drinking wine, or doing anything else that will make your brother or sister fall.

Keep what you believe about this matter, then, between yourself and God.

Happy are those who do not feel guilty when they do something they judge is right! But if they have doubts about what they eat, God condemns them when they eat it because their action is not based on faith. And anything that is not based on faith is sin.

Romans 14:1-23 GNB

LET YOUR LIFE REFLECT YOUR MESSAGE

So whoever breaks one of the least [important] of these commandments, and teaches others to do the same, will be called least [important] in the kingdom of heaven; but whoever practices and teaches them, he will be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

For I say to you that unless your righteousness (uprightness, moral essence) is more than that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. Matthew 5:19-20 AMP.

NOTHING TO BOAST OF ON YOUR KNOW IT ALL GIFT OR I'M A TEACHER OF THE WORD IF YOUR LIFE CONTRADICTS THE WORD OF GOD THAT YOU TEACH!!!

We can do ALL things through Christ Jesus that strengthens us... His Grace is sufficient for us...

Strive to be not just a teacher, or someone everyone knows to know the word, but the word is not alive in...

Jesus Christ said except our righteousness exceeds that of the Pharisees, meanwhile we tend to call Pharisees hypocrites because Christ called them so. But; let's go read about their moral lifestyles; righteousness and e.t.c ours must exceed theirs.

The roll can be called up yonder anytime, any day, anywhere. Heaven is our home Prayer,

Oh Lord, help me to be a doer of your word to the last letter oh Lord...

With man it is impossible but with you my redeemer ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE. It is possible for me to live righteously and holy.

It is possible for me to resist the world and submit to God.

It is possible for me to live every word that you have commanded oh Lord.

Quicken my inner man to daily live for you and continually die to self in the mighty name of Jesus Christ. Amen.
